- Have project work site and date pre-approved by the Bergen County Clean Communities Coordinator and confirmed prior to conducting the clean up.
- Review the Summary Report before the clean up. Keep track of the amount of litter and recyclable material collected during the clean up. RETURN THE SUMMARY REPORT WITHIN ONE MONTH OF THE CLEAN UP. (If this report is not properly completed in the allotted time, the grant may be forfeited.)
- Photographs must be taken of the garbage collected as well as participants in the act of collecting the garbage. Additional candid shots of the participants are appreciated as well. Please try to take at least 10 to 15 photos to get a good representation of your cleanup.
- Photographs should be taken with a digital camera and can be submitted by E-mail or copied to a CD or other portable device.
- Indemnify and hold harmless the County of Bergen and its employees from any accidents or injuries to persons or property resulting either directly or indirectly from participation in the Project.
- Provide proof of adequate liability insurance coverage.
- Make arrangements for proper disposal of the material collected.
- Return all items borrowed from the Bergen County Clean Communities Program (excluding used gloves and garbage bags).
