

Directions to Gilda's Club
575 Main Street, Hackensack NJ 07601

From Route 17 South:

Take Rte. 17 So. to the Rte. 4 East exit. Follow Rte. 4 past Toys 'R Us. Move into the right-hand lane and exit at the first Hackensack Ave. exit, which is before the overpass. Follow the exit around onto Hackensack Ave. Continue with directions above.

From Route 80:

Exit at the Hudson St., Hackensack exit. At the end of the ramp, follow signs for Hudson Street. As you travel north on Hudson, it will turn into Main St. by the Courthouse (on your right). Continue north on Main St. past Sears. Gilda's Club is about 3 blocks north of Sears, on your left.

From the N.J. Turnpike:

Take the turnpike north to Exit 18, after which the Turnpike becomes 1-95. Continue north to Rte. 80 West, which splits from 1-95. Follow 80-West to the Hudson St., Hackensack exit. Continue with directions for Rte. 80, above.

Garden State Parkway North:

Take GSP North to Route 80 East. Exit at the Hudson St., Hackensack exit. Continue with directions for Route 80, above. Or, take the Rte. 4 East exit. Continue with directions for Rte. 17 South, above.
