RIGHT TO KNOW WORKSHOPS TODAY**

Community Right to Know (CRTK) Workshops will be held on January 25, 2011 and February 16, 2011 at the DEP Headquarters Building, located at 401 East State Street, Trenton from 9:00-12:00pm.

The CRTK program collects, processes, and disseminates the chemical inventory, environmental release and materials accounting data required to be reported under the New Jersey Worker and Community Right to Know Act, N.J.S.A.34:5A (<http://www.njleg.state.nj.us/>). The Federal Emergency Planning and Community Right to Know Act of 1986 (EPCRA) is also known as Title III of the Superfund Amendments and reauthorization Act of 1986 (SARA). This information is used by the public, emergency planners, and first responders to determine the chemical hazards in the community.

The Bergen County Department of Health Services would like to remind businesses within the private sector that are required to report under the above-mentioned regulations and/or needs assistance in the submittal of your 2011 Community Right-To-Know Survey, to please sign-up to attend one of the workshops.
